
Non-Slewing Articulated Crane







Overview

On course completion trainees will be able to apply theory and skills in lifting and placing regular loads with a non-slewing crane and analyse and evaluate processes, through practical experience.

Prerequisites

3789 - Sling regular loads and communicate during crane operations.

Minimum verified experienced of 40 lifts (slinging and directing placement of load) with at least six variations of lifting operations that may include site, crane, loads, and communication methods.

- Prepare a non-slewing articulated crane and complete documentation for crane travel
