
4WD Training





This course teaches 4WD operators the knowledge, skills, and attributes for all essential areas of the units of competency covered under the full "best practice" guidelines for 4WD operation in the workplace.



Overview

This includes being able to drive a 4WD over varied terrain safely, effectively and responsibly to reduce driver risk. Driving techniques that minimise negative impact upon the environment are encouraged.

The course can be customised to incorporate company policies and procedures, (e.g. site entry). It can also be customised to suit the driving conditions, environment and skills required by the driver. These course options are shown in the unit standards below.

The size weight and speed of the vehicle will be relevant to the class of licence you hold.

Prerequisites

A current full class 1 licence.

- Introduction to four-wheel drive recovery techniques and equipment
