
Class 4 Truck Licence (1 Day)







Overview

This course includes a logbook unit standard (unless you can prove you have sat it with an NZTA approved provider within the last twelve months and we are happy with your current standard) and the Class 4 unit standard 17576, which consists of both theory and practical.

Prerequisites

Be 18 years of age or over.

Purchase your own Class 4 learner's licence (4L)

Held a full Class 2 licence for at least six months if under 25 or at least three months if 25 or over Current Driver's Medical certificate. (A driver's medical is valid for 5 years once lodged with NZTA). This can be obtained from your Doctor.

Logbook & Fatigue 24089, If you hold unit standard 24089, it is current and you can provide evidence (course certificate), you will be eligible to complete this training in one day.

Course Content

- Stage 1 1 Day Logbook & Fatigue 24089, If you hold unit standard 24089, it is current and you can provide evidence, you will not be required to attend on this day.
- Stage 2 2 Hours Be available for a practical training and assessment across the following 2 days, NZQA Unit Standard 17576

Unit Standards

- **24089** Demonstrate knowledge of fatigue management, work time, and driver logbook requirements
- **17576** Operate a rigid vehicle to meet the requirements for a full Class 4 driver
