Prerequisites

Students need to have 3 months of work experience in the industry prior to doing the course. Students must be able to kneel on the floor to perform CPR functions and will require use of both hands/arms. If you have students with physical limitations, please contact us to discuss.

Course Content

- Provide basic life support and first aid.
- Understand the dangers of and secure an emergency scene.
- Assess the condition of and assist a collapsed or injured person(s).
- Control foreign body airway obstructions
- Apply basic first aid to a range of medical conditions
- Manage first aid in an emergency.
