

Overview

Participants will learn to recognise different types of bleeding, including life-threatening arterial bleeding, and understand the importance of quick action. The course will cover various techniques to control bleeding and the use of emergency bandages and tourniquets. Students will also learn about the signs and symptoms of hypovolemic shock, a potentially fatal condition caused by rapid blood loss.

Prerequisites

Students must be able to kneel on the floor to perform first aid functions and will require use of both hands/arms. If you have students with physical limitations, please contact us to discuss.
