

Overview

A Class 5 Licence allows you to drive a vehicle combination 25,000kg and over. Our course includes both a Class 5 Learners and a Class 5 Full licence - we manage the entire licencing process for you. The course fee includes theory training (unit standards 24809 and 17577), learner licence fees and a practical assessment.

Prerequisites

Be 18 years of age or over.

Held a full Class 4 licence for at least six months if under 25 or at least three months if 25 or over. Have a driver's Medical certificate.

Course Content

- Stage 1 1 Day 5L Learners Licence Theory. Sit your licence test when you are ready.
- Stage 2 1 Day Logbook & Fatigue 24089, If you hold unit standard 24089, it is current and you can provide evidence, you can qualify for the reduced course options.
- Stage 3 1 Day Class 5 Licence theory for unit standard 17577.
- Stage 4 Allow 2 hours Book a time for a practical drive & assessment.

17577 Operate a combination vehicle to meet the requirements for a full Class 5 driver licence
