
Safety Observer







Overview

People credited with this unit standard are able to assist with the identification of hazards and controls; monitor adherence to safe work practices for work taking place in hazardous environments; and respond in accordance with the defined site emergency response plan should this be required.

Prerequisites

Students need to have 3 months of work experience in the industry prior to doing the course.

Course Content

- Identify criteria where a Safety Observer is required to control, monitor and maintain safety for activity.
- 🔇 Identify hazardous environments and work activities with the potential for harmful incidents that require safety observer control.
- Understand the responsibilities of a Safety Observer, including specifically for:
 - Hot Work
 - Confined Space Entrant
 - Working at Height
- Identify emergency response measures that are consistent with site emergency response plans.
