Overview

This course includes a logbook unit standard (unless you can prove you have sat it with an NZTA approved provider within the last twelve months) and the Class 2 unit standard (17574), which consists of both theory and practical.

Prerequisites

Be 18 years of age or over.

Held a full NZ car licence for at least six months

Current Driver's Medical certificate. (A driver's medical is valid for 5 years once lodged with NZTA). This can be obtained from your Doctor.

Course Content

- Stage 1 1 Day Class 2L Learners Licence Theory. Sit your licence test when you are ready.
- Stage 2 1 Day Logbook & Fatigue 24089, If you hold unit standard 24089, it is current and you can provide evidence, you will not be required to attend on this day.
- Stage 3 1 Day Class 2 Licence theory for unit standard 17574.

17574 Operate a rigid vehicle to meet the requirements for a full Class 2 driver licence
